

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BREDY LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along BREDY LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK between its junction with Bredy Road and the entrance to Bredy Farm, a distance of approximately 175 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 31 March 2025 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 04 April 2025.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out drainage works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
