

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CLIFF ROAD, BURTON BRADSTOCK

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along CLIFF ROAD, BURTON BRADSTOCK between its junction with Southover and Cliff Farm, a distance of approximately 155 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 27 January 2026 between 0930 and 1530 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 January 2026.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway resurfacing works.

On this occasion there will be no specified alternative route for diverted traffic.
