

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHIPTON LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along SHIPTON LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK between Kennon Lodge and Uplands, a distance of approximately 260 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 05 March 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 06 March 2026.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out permanent reinstatement.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3157 - A35 - Shipton Road
