

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHIPTON LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along SHIPTON LANE, BURTON BRADSTOCK between its junction with Annings Lane and the entrance to Bramley House, a distance of approximately 455 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 0930 and 1530 on 19 August 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 19 August 2026.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to carry out urgent works in the highway to restore customer service.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3157 - A35 - Shipton Road
